

Leaf Collection Guidelines

From mid-October until mid-December, as needed or until the Village truck is converted to plow snow.

- Leaves should be piled at the curb, just behind the curb but extending no more than 8 feet into yard. Leaves must not be placed in the street because they will clog gutters and storm drains and may constitute a traffic hazard.
- Keep grass, brush clippings and other debris (i.e. rocks, gravel, trash, metal) separate from the leaves. Leaf piles containing brush and other debris will not be picked up
- Leaf piles blocked by parked cars or low hanging tree limbs will not be picked up.
- Do not place leaves around fire hydrants, mailboxes, sign posts or guy wires.
- Weather permitting, leaves will be picked up in each area of the Village once a week.

Brush Collection Guidelines

Hired Contractors are required to remove any tree limbs, trunks, logs, brush, etc., that they generate from your property. This material will not be collected by Village workers if placed at the curb.

- Manageable amounts of storm debris (limbs, brush, etc.) will be picked up by Village workers. FEMA will be contacted concerning large amounts of storm damage.
- Up to one truck load of yard debris created by the resident (not a contractor) will be removed by Village workers. More than one truck load of debris can be hauled, by the resident, to a Village facility provided a Village worker is there to supervise the dumpsite. Anyone who suspects they may generate more than one truckload of yard debris should contact the Street Department to pre-arrange an agreement.
- Grass clippings and small amounts of leaves should be placed in paper bags available at the Village office for no charge.
- Limbs should be no more than ten feet in length.
- Vines and limbs with thorns should be cut into 4-foot lengths and bundled and tied with string (no wire).
- Different types of material should be set out in separate areas.
- Materials such as rocks, bricks, pipes, wire, fencing materials including posts, and small amount of twigs, leaves, grass should be disposed of with your trash.
